The MA in Biblical Mission and Wellness degree is a two-year program. It follows Jesus' method of disciple-making and evangelism. In this program, students spend approximately one semester on campus to complete the core courses of the program and complete training in a local church environment.

The MA in Biblical Mission and Wellness degree

- Includes exposure to health evangelism and classes on natural healing remedies, diet, and rectifying lifestyle-related health challenges.
- Emphasizes comprehensive health and an understanding of nutritional and lifestyle therapy.
- Includes national and international retreats for prayer, training, and benchmarking opportunities.
- Pairs students with an experienced mentor during practicums.



BE A GOOD NEIGHBOR

Since August 2017, Weimar University's weekly service program called Total Community Involvement (TCI) has gotten attention. Even peer reviewers from an accrediting team have especially recognized TCI and its impact.

Each week, students, faculty, and staff spend a half-day meeting individual and group needs in the surrounding communities. It's yardwork, decluttering, helping people moving, health education for individuals and groups, healthy cooking demos, visiting with invalids and the lonely, and more.

Thanks to private donations, TCI teams have been able to give over 2.5 million dollars' worth of their time in free medical care and other services since TCI began. It's our way of sincerely and practically sharing the gospel through a helping hand, a smile, or a conversation that can all lead to Christ.
