The Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) degree program prepares nurses who are able to teach and promote principles that prevent disease. Students gain clinical experience in hospitals, Weimar's NEWSTART Lifestyle Program, and the Nedley Depression an Anxiety Recovery Program. Graduates of Weimar University's nursing programs will be effective medical-missionary nurses who exemplify the caring ministry of Jesus Christ.

Weimar University's ASN and BSN

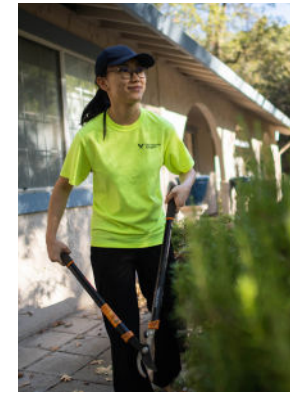
1. California Board of Registered Nursing approved.
2. Nursing program accredited by Accreditation Commission for Education in Nursing (ACEN).
3. NCLEX eligible after four semesters of nursing classes.
4. Graduates have achieved a 93% NCLEX pass rate since the program's inception.
5. Graduates sought by employers because of unique preparation in health promotion.
6. Evidence-based nursing process (assessment, analysis, planning, implementation, and evaluation).
7. 100% of graduates are working as RNs or serving as missionaries.
8. Access to high-paying jobs upon graduation from nursing school.

The ASN program may be completed in four semesters after the pre-nursing courses are completed. Pre-nursing classes are 3-semester long and include health and religion courses. The nursing program consists of classroom activities, simulation laboratory sessions, and clinical time in skilled nursing facilities, acute care hospitals, and outpatient settings. Some clinical facilities are far from the university and transportation is provided. All pre-nursing courses must be completed before starting the nursing program. The BSN degree may be completed along with the ASN courses with the addition of one semester after finishing the ASN.



BE A GOOD NEIGHBOR

Since August 2017, Weimar University's weekly service program called Total Community Involvement (TCI) has gotten attention. Even peer reviewers from an accrediting team have especially recognized TCI and its impact.

Each week, students, faculty, and staff spend a half-day meeting individual and group needs in the surrounding communities. It includes yardwork, decluttering, helping people move, health education for individuals and groups, healthy cooking demos, visiting with invalids and the lonely, and more.

Thanks to private donations, TCI teams have been able to give over 2.5 million dollars' worth of their time in free medical care and other services since TCI began. It's our way of sincerely and practically sharing the gospel through a helping hand, a smile, or a conversation that can all lead to Christ.
